Tournament Guideline and Rules

Cornhole Boards

1. The boards will be placed 27 feet apart (front to front).
2. The cornhole board surface should be 2' x 4'.
3. Each board will have a 6-in. hole, centered 9" from the back and 12" from either side.

Cornhole Bags

1. There should be 8 bags, 4 bags of each color
2. Each bag should be 6" x 6" with 1 pound of corn inserted into each bag.

Points System

- 3 Points for a cornhole bag that goes through the hole.
- 1 Point for a cornhole bag that is on the playing surface.
- 1 Point for a cornhole bag that is hanging into the hole.
- 1 Point for a cornhole bag that is hanging off the edge but not touching the ground.
- 0 Points for a cornhole bag that is on the playing surface but is also touching the ground.
- 0 Points for a cornhole bag that is hanging off the front edge and is resting on a cornhole bag that is on the ground. However, if you can remove the bag on the ground without the one on the board falling, then a point is given.

Scoring

1. The team with the highest round score adds the difference of the two scores to its game score.
2. The team that wins the round is given honors to throw first in the next round.
3. If both cornhole teams have the same round score then the game score stays the same and honors stay with the team who had it the previous round.
4. A team earns 3 points for cornhole bags that go into the hole. They must go completely into the hole. Bags that are hanging in the hole count only 1 point. If an opponent knocks your bag into the hole you still get the 3 points.

Cornhole Fouls

1. A cornhole player's foot goes past the foot foul line. (front of the cornhole board)
2. A player goes out of turn.
 - The throw the foul occurs on is voided. If the bag is on the board, it is removed.

Game Play

1. In doubles play partners shall stand at opposite cornhole boards.
2. Each cornhole team will have 4 bags of one color.
3. All 8 cornhole bags begin at one end.
4. Each game will be played with 4 players (2 teams).
5. Opponents alternate tosses until all 8 bags are played.

6. The team who has honors will begin play by throwing a cornhole bag at the opposite cornhole board.
7. A cornhole player may throw from either side of the board but must stay on that side for the entire round.
8. If a cornhole bag hits the ground then bounces up onto the board, remove that bag for it does not count.
9. Count the points scored during the round. If no team has reached the 21 point mark start the next round until a team reaches 21. The team that scores the highest number of points on the previous round will have honors. No bags shall be touched until both teams agree on that round's score.
10. The first team to accumulate 21 or more points wins the game! That team will advance to the next round. The losing team is eliminated from the tournament.
11. The score is the difference in the teams' totals. For example: After 1 round or 8 bags played, Team #1 has thrown 1 bag into the hole and 3 off the board; their total then is 3 points. Team #2 has thrown 1 bag on the board and 3 off the board; their total then is 1 point. Subtract Team #2's score from Team #1's and the total score for the round is Team #1 earns 2 points.
12. To start each match the teams will be allowed one free round to warm up for the game.
13. The BOW Cornhole Tournament Committee reserves the right to make additional rules and regulations if and as the situation warrants.
14. All decisions of the BOW Cornhole Tournament Committee are final. Violations of any rules or regulations may result in a team being disqualified.
15. The tournament is limited to the first 32 teams to register and pay entry fees.
16. Bracket seeding will be completed using a blind draw.
17. First Round approximate starting times will be posted on Friday, April 15th at the Broadway Town Hall.
18. The BOW Cornhole Tournament Committee will appoint 2 - 4 individuals to serve as Cornhole Tournament Officials.
19. Tournament Officials are allowed to play in the tournament, but they will not be allowed to officiate any game in which they are involved.
20. Any team not ready for play will be eliminated from the tournament. The opposing team will advance to the next round. If neither team is available, both will be eliminated.
21. The Tournament will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 21, 2012.
22. The Tournament location is in the area of the North Carolina Veterans Memorial located at 210 S. Main Street.
